AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ELEVATOR APPEALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11A of Chapter 22 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 801 of the Acts of 1963, is hereby further
3 amended by striking the fourth paragraph and inserting in place
4 thereof the following paragraph:

5 Each member of the board, except the chairman, shall be paid
6 seventy-five dollars for each day while in the actual performance of
7 his duties as such, but not exceeding twelve hundred and fifty
8 dollars in any fiscal year. The chairman of the board shall receive
9 one hundred dollars for each day while in the actual performance
10 of his duties as such, but not exceeding twelve hundred and fifty
11 dollars in any fiscal year. Each member, including the chairman,
12 shall also receive from the commonwealth all expenses necessarily
13 incurred by him in connection with his official duties.
