AN ACT REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 139 of Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new para-  
3 graph: —

4 A conviction of a violation of this section or any adjudication  
5 that a person is a delinquent child by reason thereof shall be  
6 reported forthwith by the court or magistrate to the registrar of  
7 motor vehicles who shall revoke immediately the license to operate  
8 motor vehicles or the right to operate motor vehicles of the person  
9 so convicted or adjudged, and no appeal, motion for new trial or  
10 exceptions shall operate to stay the revocation of such license or  
11 right to operate. The registrar of motor vehicles after having  
12 revoked the license or right to operate of any such person so  
13 convicted or adjudged shall issue a new license or reinstate such  
14 right to operate, if the prosecution of such person is finally termi-  
15 nated in his favor; otherwise, no new license shall be issued nor  
16 shall such right to operate be reinstated until sixty days after the  
17 date of revocation following his original conviction or adjudica-  
18 tion if for a first offense, or until one year after the date of revoca-  
19 tion following any subsequent conviction or adjudication.
