AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 133 or chapter 351 of the acts of 1981, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end thereof the following
4 paragraph:

5 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, an application for
6 examination or registration shall contain the following question:
7 "Have you been convicted of a criminal offense other than drun-
8 keness, simple assault, speeding, traffic violation, affray, or dis-
9 turbance of the peace? ()yes ()no. If yes, please indicate
10 the date, court, offense charged and the penalty imposed." Each
11 applicant shall answer such question.
