In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT GRANTING RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (0) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following two
3 sentences: —

4 Any member who served on a school committee of a city or town
5 as a result of election by direct vote of the people and in which
6 position no compensation was paid or received, may establish
7 credit for such service by depositing in the annuity savings fund of
8 the system of which he is a member a sum equal to the amount
9 which would have been paid into such fund during such period of
10 such position had been compensated at the rate of twenty-five
11 hundred dollars per year, plus regular interest to the date of pay-
12 ments. Any member who served on a board of water commissioners
13 of a city or town, either elected by direct vote of the people or
14 appointed to said position by the selectmen, mayor, or executive
15 head of a city or town; and in which position no compensation was
16 paid or received, may establish credit for such service by depositing
17 in the annuity savings fund of the system of which he is a member a
18 sum equal to the amount which would have been paid into such
19 fund during such period of such position had been compensated at
20 the rate of twenty-five hundred dollars for year, plus regular
21 interest to the date of payments.
