AN ACT FOR THE PROVISION OF DAY CARE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any plan which is wholly or partially state-funded for
2 commercial or real estate development or renovation involving
3 a minimum of 50,000 square feet of space shall include child care
4 facilities for low and moderate income employees located in said
5 building. This requirement may be met by the provision of non-
6 profit on-site day care facilities rendered in accord with Chapter
7 28A of the General Laws, or by allocating funds in the amount
8 of two dollars per square foot of new or renovated space for the
9 provision of off-site day care services for all low and moderate
10 income employees.
