**AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING A MASSACHUSETTS HIGHER EDUCATION ASSISTANCE CORPORATION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 298 of the acts of 1956, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following definitions, "long term  
3 nursing care student", any student who receives a loan from this  
4 corporation for the purpose of nursing education or for specialized  
5 geriatric education and who will stipulate that they will work in the  
6 long term nursing care industry for each year that said student  
7 receives a ten percent forgiveness of said loan not to exceed five  
8 years.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 298 as so amended, is hereby further  
2 amended by inserting in section 4 the following clause:

3 (c $\frac{1}{2}$ )To make loans to any student, or graduate student, who  
4 attends any approved nursing institution and who stipulates that  
5 they will work in the long term nursing care industry for each year  
6 that they receive financial assistance under this act, not to exceed  
7 five years in the aggregate; will receive a forgiveness of the loan of  
8 ten percent per year for each year that they are employed in said  
9 nursing care industry. Said students shall be permitted to borrow  
10 up to five thousand dollars per year with a maximum of twenty-five  
11 thousand dollars. Said student and long term nursing care  
12 employer must verify to said corporation of the employment of the  
13 student.
