

By Mrs. Murray of Cohasset, petition of Mary Jeanette Murray and William B. Golden relative to authorizing the Division of Capital Planning and Operations to exchange certain land in the town of Hull with the redevelopment authority of said town. Housing and Urban Development.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO EXCHANGE CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF HULL WITH THE HULL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The deputy commissioner of capital planning and operations is
2 hereby authorized, subject to the provisions of sections 40E
3 through 40J inclusive of chapter 7 of the General Laws, to convey
4 in fee under such terms and conditions as mutually agreed between
5 the division of capital planning and operations, in consultation
6 with the metropolitan district commission, and the Hull Redevel-
7 opment Authority, two parcels of land acquired by the metropoli-
8 tan district commission for park and reservation purposes to the
9 Hull Redevelopment Authority to be used for parking purposes
10 under the Hull Urban Redevelopment project.

11 PARCEL 1 consisting of 51,895 square feet more or less as
12 shown on plan accession number 37435-VT, dated December 10,
13 1958, signed by Benjamin W. Fink, Director Parks Engineering,
14 recorded Plymouth County Registry of Deeds on December 29,
15 1958 in book 2676, page 62.

16 PARCEL 2 consisting of approximately 4,012 square feet more
17 or less as shown on plan accession number 37719-VT dated March
18 13, 1959, signed by Benjamin W. Fink, Director Parks Engineer-
19 ing, recorded Plymouth County Registry of Deeds on April 23,
20 1959 in book 2695, page 220.

21 Consideration for these conveyances shall be the conveyance of
 22 parcels 3A and 4 owned by the Hull Redevelopment Authority
 23 contiguous to the aforementioned parcels and further identified on
 24 a plan on file at the Hull Redevelopment Authority, to the division
 25 of capital planning and operations.
