AN ACT AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT TO THE TOWN OF WINTHROP FOR EXPENDITURES TO PROTECT THE TOWN FROM HAZARDS RELATED TO SEWAGE AND REFUSE DISPOSAL AT DEER ISLAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the state treasurer shall reimburse the
3 town of Winthrop in an amount not to exceed one hundred fifty
4 thousand dollars for extraordinary and unforeseen expenditures
5 for technical, legal and related services necessary to adequately
6 protect the health, safety, welfare, environment and property
7 values of the town from operations and expanded operations of
8 the Metropolitan District Commission of sewerage and in
9 disposing of sewage, sludge and related refuse materials including
10 hazardous and potentially hazardous materials at Deer Island.

1 SECTION 2. Payment shall be made to the town of Winthrop
2 upon presentation to the state treasurer of bills for such services
3 certified by the town account of the town of Winthrop and approv-
4 ed by the board of selectmen.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
