AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF OFFICIALLY MARKED POLICE CRUISERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is amended by adding after
2 Section 9A, the following section:

3 Section 9B. The provisions of this chapter regarding the regis-
4 tration of motor vehicles shall not apply to officially marked police
5 cruisers owned or leased by the Commonwealth or its political
6 sub-divisions; except that a list be furnished to the Registrar no
7 later than December thirty-first of each year, giving the make,
8 model year, VIN, and register number assigned to all such official-
9 ly marked police cruisers.
