AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO ESTABLISH A SEVENTY-TWO HOUR MAXIMUM STORAGE CHARGE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES THAT HAVE BEEN INVOLUNTARILY TOWED BY POLICE REQUEST.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 158B, Section 6C is hereby amended by adding after the  
2 last sentence — “The Department shall establish a seventy-two  
3 hour maximum storage charge for all vehicles that have been  
4 involuntarily towed both during snow removal and other times at  
5 police request.”
