AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LOCAL OPTION IN EMPLOYMENT OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS AND SUPERVISORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 41 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place thereof
3 the following paragraph: —

4 A school committee may award a contract to a superintendent of
5 schools or to an administrator or supervisor, which terms shall
6 mean and include the positions of administrative assistant, director
7 of pupil personnel, special education director, business manager,
8 guidance director, coordinator, supervisor, principal, vice princi-
9 pal or unit director or any position of different name the duties of
10 which are substantially similar to those of any named position, for
11 a period not exceeding six years. Nothing in this section shall be
12 construed to prevent a school committee from voting to employ a
13 superintendent of schools or any such administrator or supervisor
14 who has served as such in its public schools for the three previous
15 consecutive school years to serve at its discretion.
