AN ACT RELATIVE TO PARTY DESIGNATIONS ON BALLOTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary any ballot used in a
- 2 state, county, or municipal election shall have a party affiliation
- 3 printed next to the candidate's name.
