AN ACT OUTLAWING THE POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS KNIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of Chapter 269 of the General Laws as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 516 of the Acts of 1983 is hereby amended by
- 3 inserting after the word "dagger" in sentence one the following: or
- 4 any device or case which enables a knife to be drawn at a locked
- 5 position,.
