By Mr. White of Boston, petition of the Mass. Federation of Teachers, AFT, AFL-CIO, and W. Paul White that certain teachers be credited with service in non-public schools for purposes of retirement. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN TEACHERS SHALL BE CREDITED WITH SERVICE TO NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of Section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (1) the following
3 paragraph: (1½)Any member of a retirement system who is
4 engaged in a teaching position and who formerly was employed
5 in a teacher position in a non-public school may establish such
6 service as creditable service by depositing in the annuity savings
7 fund of which he is a member an amount equal to five percent
8 of the compensation received during such period of service, plus
9 regular interest to the date of deposit.

10 Provided the teacher's non-public school teaching was in a
11 school certified by the State Department of Education and at the
12 time he was teaching in the non-public school he was fully
13 qualified to teach in a public school.
