AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF HYPOTHERMIA THERMOMETERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 3 of chapter
2 111C of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter
3 516 of the acts of 1981, is further amended by inserting after the
4 first sentence the words: provided that, no other law to the con-
5 trary, all licensed ambulances shall be equipped with hypothermia
6 thermometers.

1 SECTION 2. Section 53 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 674 of the acts of
3 1979, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "facili-
4 ties" in the third sentence, the words: including, but not limited to,
5 hypothermia thermometers.

1 SECTION 3. The first paragraph of section 72 of chapter 111
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of
3 chapter 528 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting after the words "nursing care", in the second sentence, the
5 words: including, but not limited to, hypothermia thermometers.,.
