AN ACT TO DIRECT THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO ALLOW RESIDENTS OF CHELSEA AND OF THE CHARLESTOWN DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON TO DRIVE OVER THE MAURICE J. TOBIN BRIDGE WITHOUT THE PAYMENT OF TOLLS OR CHARGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby directed to allow
- 2 residents of the city of Chelsea and residents of that part of Boston
- 3 known as the Charlestown district to drive pleasure vehicles over
- 4 the Maurice J. Tobin Bridge without toll or charge.
