AN ACT REGULATING TRAVEL AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 49A the following section: -
- 3 Section 49B. Every travel agency pursuant to the provisions of
- 4 this chapter shall deliver and file with the division a surety com-
- 5 pany bond, written by a company recognized and approved by the
- 6 commissioner of insurance and approved by the division with
- 7 respect to its form, manner of execution and sufficiency in one
- 8 form to the commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the principal sum
- 9 of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), provided, however, the liabil-
- 10 ity of the surety on the bond shall be limited to indemnify the
- 11 claimant only for actual damage. Such bond shall not limit or
- 12 impair any right of recovery otherwise available pursuant to law
- 13 nor shall the amount of the bond be relevant in determining the
- 14 amount of damage or other relief to which any claimant shall be
- 15 entitled. The division may revoke the registration whenever the
- 16 bond ceases to be in full force and effect.
