## AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 41 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is
- 2 hereby amended by striking entire paragraph and replacing it with
- 3 the following: —
- 4 "The fees which notaries public shall charge for oaths, acknowl-
- 5 edgements and notarizations shall in no case exceed \$1.00 for the
- 6 first signature and \$.50 for each additional signature."
- 1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of chapter 222 of the General Laws, as
- 2 amended by chapter 18 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended by
- 3 adding the following new sentence: -
- 4 All other commissioners shall charge a fee of no more than five
- 5 dollars for administering such oaths.
