AN ACT AUTHORIZING CALVIN ARTERBERRY TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES EXAMINER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
2 the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for
3 appointment as a Registry of Motor Vehicles examiner, Calvin
4 Arterberry of the city of New Bedford shall be eligible to take the
5 next open competitive examination for appointment to the position
6 of examiner and, provided he meets all other requirements, shall be
7 eligible for certification and appointment.
