AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALARIES FOR REGISTERS OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33 of Chapter 36 of the General Laws as appearing in
2 the 1984 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out the
3 second paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph:

5 The salaries of the registers of deeds for the County of Suffolk
6 and the southern district of Middlesex County and their assistants
7 shall be as follows:

8 Register: A sum equivalent to seventy-five percent of the salary
9 of an associate justice of the superior court.

10 First Assistant Register: A sum equivalent to the salary of the
11 first assistant clerk of the superior court department for civil busi-
12 ness in the counties of Suffolk and Middlesex.

13 All other assistant registers: a sum equivalent to the salaries of
14 the assistant clerks of the superior court department for civil busi-
15 ness in the counties of Suffolk and Middlesex.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1
