AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. G.L. c.4, s.7 (26) is amended by deleting the entire
2 paragraph and inserting in its place the following: —
3 (c) personnel, medical and other data relating to a specifically
4 named individual, the disclosure of which would constitute a
5 clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
