AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE OF PERSONS OVER THE AGE OF SIXTY-FIVE FROM SEIZURE OR EXECUTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 34 of chapter 235 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding the following clause: — Seventeen, Estate of real property
3 of persons sixty-five years of age or older used as such persons
4 residence; provided, however, that a declaration of homestead
5 protection has been filed for recording at the registry of deeds
6 where the property is located.
