## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT PERMITTING THE BURNING OF LEAVES AT CERTAIN TIMES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 142J the following section: —

3 *Section 142K.* Notwithstanding the provisions of section one  
4 hundred and forty-two A and one hundred and forty-two B of this  
5 chapter or any other provision of law to the contrary, any person  
6 during the last two weeks of October and the first week of  
7 November of each year may conduct the open burning of leaves.  
8 Said person shall obtain a permit as provided in section thirteen of  
9 chapter forty-eight.
