AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING AUTOMOBILE WARRANTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90, Section 7N½ of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by addition at the end thereof a new subsection: (8) Failure to set up
3 an arbitration panel as specified in this section shall constitute
4 prima facie evidence of a violation of Chapter 93A of the General
5 Laws.
