AN ACT RELATIVE TO SUPERINTENDENTS OF SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71, Section 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by addition at the end thereof the following: —
- 3 A superintendent employed under this section or section sixty or
- 4 sixty-three shall give a monthly written report to the responsible
- 5 school committee indicating the number of students over sixteen
- 6 years of age who have left the school system and who have not
- 7 transferred to another school as a full-time student.
