AN ACT ESTABLISHING NOTICE REQUIREMENTS RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN SUBPOENAS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 68 of chapter 277 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding the following paragraph: —

3 In any case where said attorney general, district attorney, or any
4 other party to a criminal proceeding, shall subpoena any police
5 officer or law enforcement official to testify as a witness the sub-
6 poena shall be served at least three days prior to the date upon
7 which said police officer or law enforcement official is scheduled
8 to testify.
