AN ACT AUTHORIZING PAUL MYLETT TO TAKE THE NEXT OPEN COMPETITIVE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule  
2 to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for  
3 appointment as a police officer, Paul Mylett shall be eligible to take  
4 the next open competitive entrance examination for police officer  
5 in the City of Boston, and, provided he meets all other require-  
6 ments, shall be eligible for certification and appointment as a police  
7 officer in the City of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act will take effect upon its passage.

By His Excellency the Governor, in Council, I have the pleasure to inform you that the Bill for the purpose of amending the provisions of the Act relating to the appointment of the members of the Council of the Government has been passed by the Council of the Government and the Governor has assented thereto. The Bill is now in force.

**TO AMEND THE GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL ACT, 1956**

Enacted by the Council of the Government of West Bengal on the 15th day of August, 1975.

**SECTION 1.** Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Government of West Bengal (Amendment) Act, 1975.  
(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Government may, by notification, appoint in this behalf.

**SECTION 2.** The Government of West Bengal Act, 1956 shall be amended as follows:
