By Mr. Lemanski of Chicopee, petition of Kenneth M. Lemanski for an investigation and study by the committee on Commerce and Labor relative to employment training laws in the Commonwealth. Commerce and Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

Ordered, That the committee on Commerce and Labor shall be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to employment training Laws in the Commonwealth.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
