AN ACT REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT OF CABINET SECRETARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 3 of chapter 6A of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in section 3 of chapter 704 of the acts of 1969, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following words: — subject, however, to the
4 approval of the majority of the committee consisting of the follow-
5 ing persons: senate chairman of ways and means, house chairman
6 of judiciary, senate chairman of transportation, house chairman of
7 rules, senate chairman of banks and banking, house chairman of
8 counties, senate chairman of education, house chairman of election
9 laws, senate chairman of energy, house chairman of ethics, senate
10 chairman of government regulations, house chairman of health
11 care, senate chairman of insurance, house chairman of natural
12 resources and agriculture and the house chairman of taxation.
