RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE USE OF STATE-OWNED LAND FOR MOBILE HOME PARKS.

- 1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two members
- 2 of the senate, three members of the house of representatives and
- 3 four persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established
- 4 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to
- 5 the use of state- owned land for mobile home parks.

## The Constitution of the Republic

Article 1. The Republic of the United States of America is a

democratic republic composed of free, independent, and equal States

which are united in a compact for their common benefit.

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
