## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENTS FOR THE ELDERLY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause 41B, of said section 5 of said chapter 59,  
2 inserted by section 5 of chapter 653 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out in the first sentence the words "except for  
4 any portion of said property which produces income", and insert-  
5 ing in place thereof the words "unless said real property contains  
6 more than three dwelling units".

1 SECTION 2. Clause 41B, of said section 5 of said chapter 59,  
2 inserted by section 5 of Chapter 653 of the Acts of 1982, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out in the second sentence the words "except  
4 for any portion of said property which produces income", and  
5 inserting in place thereof the words "unless said real property  
6 contains more than three dwelling units".
