AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADDITION OF SEVERAL SERVICES TO THE RANGE OF HOME CARE SERVICES NOW PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of Chapter 19A of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by Chapter 393 of the Acts of 1979, is hereby amended in  
3 subparagraph (c) by inserting after the words "protective services"  
4 the following: — respite care, elder foster care, escort services, day  
5 care, .
