**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANNING.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission is hereby established for  
2 the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the  
3 feasibility of providing adequate measures for the protection of  
4 public health and safety in the event of a Radiological Emergency  
5 at the Seabrook (New Hampshire) Station Nuclear Power Plant.

6 Said commission shall consist of the Secretary of Energy, Secre-  
7 tary of Public Safety, Director of Massachusetts Civil Defense  
8 Agency, one member of the Massachusetts Senate, one member of  
9 the Massachusetts House of Representatives, two individuals to be  
10 appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be expert in radia-  
11 tion health, and one of whom shall be expert in transportation, and  
12 one individual each from the towns of Amesbury, Merrimac, New-  
13 bury, Salisbury, West Newbury, and from the City of Newbury-  
14 port, to be appointed by the legislative bodies of said communities,  
15 or their designees.

16 Said commission shall expend such funds as are appropriated by  
17 the General Court for the purpose of conducting this study.

18 Said commission shall report to the General Court and to the  
19 governor the results of its investigation and study and its recom-  
20 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to  
21 carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with the  
22 clerk of the Senate on or before December thirty-one, nineteen  
23 hundred and eighty-six.
