AN ACT RELATIVE TO GROUP CREDIT ACCIDENT AND HEALTH AND GROUP CREDIT LIFE INSURANCE POLICIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of subdivision (A) of section  
2 110 of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1984  
3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out clause (j) and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following clause: — (j) a creditor,  
5 lessor or vendor, or a parent holding company, affiliate, associate,  
6 subsidiary, association trustee or trustees of any one or more of  
7 them, under which debtors, guarantors, lessees or purchasers are  
8 insured against loss of time resulting from disease or specified  
9 bodily injuries.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 133 of said chapter  
2 175 is hereby amended by striking out clause (c), as amended by  
3 chapter 237 of the acts of 1985, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following clause: — (c) the debtors, guarantors, lessees or pur-  
5 chasers of a creditor, lessor or vendor, or a parent holding compa-  
6 ny, affiliate, associate, subsidiary, association, trustee or trustees  
7 of any one or more of them, or of an insurance company for a  
8 policy loan, written under a policy issued to such creditor, lessor or  
9 vendor, or a parent holding company, affiliate, associate, subsid-  
10 iary, association, trustee or trustees of any one or more of them,  
11 and made payable thereto or to any assignee thereof, insuring the  
12 lives of debtors, guarantors, lessees or purchasers, with or without  
13 evidence of insurability; or.
