AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A FIFTH ASSISTANT REGISTER OF THE PROBATE AND FAMILY COURT DEPARTMENT, PLYMOUTH DIVISION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws as most recently amended by
2 chapter 478 of the acts of 1978, is further amended by striking out
3 section 23A and inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 23A.* In addition to the first assistant registers of pro-
5 bate provided for in section twenty-three, the judges of the respec-
6 tive divisions of the probate and family court department for the
7 following counties may appoint assistant registers with the same
8 powers and duties. Said appointments shall be as follows: —

- 9 Barnstable, one assistant register
- 10 Berkshire, one assistant register
- 11 Bristol, three assistant registers
- 12 Essex, three assistant registers
- 13 Hampden, three assistant registers
- 14 Middlesex, five assistant registers
- 15 Norfolk, five assistant registers
- 16 Plymouth, four assistant registers
- 17 Suffolk, five assistant registers
- 18 Worcester, four assistant registers.

CHAPTER 217 OF THE STATUTES AT LARGE, AS ENACTED BY CONGRESS IN SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, MAY 22, 1918, IS AMENDED BY ADDING TO SECTION 114 AND REPEALING IN SECTION 115, AS FOLLOWS:

- 114. In addition to the first national reserve region here provided for in section 114, there shall be established in the States of New York and New Jersey, and in the District of Columbia, two additional reserve regions, to be known as the New York and New Jersey reserve region and the District of Columbia reserve region, respectively, and the provisions of this section shall apply to such reserve regions as if they were reserve regions established under section 114.
