AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING RESTRAINT OF TRADE OR COMMERCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws, as most recently added by sec-
2 tion 1 of Chapter 459 of the Acts of 1978, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after section 4, the following section: —

4 *Section 4A.* The commonwealth, its political subdivisions,
5 departments, agencies and commissions will assure that all for
6 profit and not for profit corporations and other legal entities
7 engaged in trade or commerce in the commonwealth are given fair
8 and nondiscriminatory consideration in the letting of bids and
9 granting of contracts or subcontracts under which state monies
10 are to be used in whole or in part, and to assure that all for profit
11 and not for profit corporations and other legal entities are given
12 fair and equal access to all relevant and needed information relat-
13 ing to the bidding on any contract granted by the commonwealth.
