## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO CONVEY LAND IN LANCASTER TO THE DIVISION OF TOURISM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 This division of capital planning and operations, in the name and  
2 on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to grant and  
3 convey, by a deed approved also to form by the attorney general, to  
4 the division of tourism for use as a tourist information center, the  
5 former Howard Johnson restaurant on route two in the town of  
6 Lancaster under control of the department of public works.

7 The boundaries of this conveyance are to be mutually agreed on  
8 between the department of public works and the division of tourism.

As the Director of Education, I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th inst. in relation to the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of New York, and to advise you that the same has been referred to the Committee on Education, and that the same will be reported to the Senate at the next session of the Legislature.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

ARTICLE I. Section 1. The Legislative Power of this State shall be vested in a Senate and an Assembly.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twenty-four Members, and the Assembly of fifty Members.

Section 3. The Members of the Senate shall be chosen for a term of two years, and the Members of the Assembly for a term of one year. The Senate shall be organized on the 1st day of January following the election of its Members, and the Assembly on the 1st day of January following the election of its Members.
