AN ACT TO REDUCE WELFARE FRAUD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 35 of chapter 6A of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section one of chapter 524 of the acts of 1980, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting after the first paragraph the follow-
4 ing paragraph: —

5 Each year, the bureau of long term care of the rate setting
6 commission shall conduct field audits of not less than fifteen
7 percent of long term providers which fall under the jurisdiction
8 of said bureau.
