AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF CERTAIN SAFETY DEVICES IN MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the definition of "occupant crash
3 protection device", as appearing in section 1 of chapter 416 of the
4 acts of 1985.

1 SECTION 2. Section five of chapter four hundred and sixteen
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty-five is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. Section eight of said chapter four hundred and
2 sixteen is hereby repealed.
