By Mr. Rea of Billerica, petition of Michael J. Rea, Jr., and another for legislation to transfer the registration of motor vehicles from the Registry of Motor Vehicles to cities and towns. Public Safety.

AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES FROM THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter ninety of the General
- 2 Laws, the registration of motor vehicles shall be done by cities and
- 3 towns in a manner prescribed by the selectmen or mayor. Such
- 4 cities and towns shall collect sales and excise taxes in conjunction
- 5 with the sale and registration of all motor vehicles. Cities and
- 6 towns which provide registration services under the provisions of
- 7 this act shall charge and retain reasonable fees for such services.
