AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMPENSATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 81T the following section: —
- 3 Section 81U. A professional engineer who remains at the site
- 4 of a construction project beyond the scheduled completion date
- 5 shall be paid for such service by the general contractor. A general
- 6 contractor who violates the provisions of this section shall be
- 7 liable in civil action to the engineer or his employer.
