AN ACT RELATIVE TO NOTIFICATION OF MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS OF CERTAIN ACTIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956 is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting at the end of paragraph four the following: —
- 3 Said secretary-treasurer shall cause to be sent, Written
- 4 notification to each elected state and municipal official whose
- 5 district may be affected by any action taken by said authority.
- 6 Written notice shall be sent thirty days prior to the commencement
- 7 of any action taken by the authority. Actions taken by the
- 8 authority include but are not limited to the following: zoning
- 9 changes, land use changes, development plans, community
- 10 relations projects, environmental impact studies, executory and
- 11 non-executory contracts, and existing agreements entered into by
- 12 the authority.
