AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC FINANCING OF THE 1990 ELECTION FOR GOVERNOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Every individual who files a separate tax return pursuant to
- 2 chapter sixty-two of the General Laws and whose income tax
- 3 liability for any taxable year is one dollar or more shall, for the
- 4 taxable years nineteen hundred and eighty-six, nineteen hundred
- 5 and eighty-seven, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight and
- 6 nineteen hundred and eighty-nine, contribute one dollar of such
- 7 liability to a state election campaign fund, to be administered by
- 8 the director of campaign finance for the financing of the election
- 9 for the office of governor in the year nineteen hundred and ninety.
- 10 In the case of a joint return of the husband and wife having
- 11 a tax liability of two dollars or more, each spouse shall contribute
- 12 one dollar to the fund.
