AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT A FUEL TRANSFER PIPELINE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, department  
3 of public works is hereby authorized and directed to construct a  
4 fuel transfer pipeline in the town and county of Nantucket, Massa-  
5 chusetts to be located in Nantucket Harbor on that portion of  
6 land owned by the town of Nantucket off of Washington Street  
7 Extension — bounded northwest by Natican Realty Company,  
8 northeast by Nantucket Harbor, southeast by Shore Reservation  
9 and southwest by Washington Street Extension.

1 SECTION 2. This fuel transfer pipe will be constructed on a  
2 parcel of land designated as a commercial pier site as authorized  
3 under Chapter 225 Acts of 1984.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall not take effect until approved by  
2 a majority of the voters at a town meeting in the town of  
3 Nantucket.
