AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CERTIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF JAMES REED KEITH AS A POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 certification for appointment of James Reed Keith as a police
4 officer, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
6 convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The administrator of the division of personnel administratin
2 shall certify James Reed Keith for appointment as a police officer
3 according to the grade he received in the examination for police
4 officer held on March eighth, nineteen hundred and eighty-six,
5 notwithstanding the fact that he had attained the maximum age
6 for said position; provided, however, that he fulfills all other
7 requirements for certification as such police officer.
