AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REIMBURSEMENT FOR LOSS OF TAXES FOR CERTAIN STATE LANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of Section 13 of chapter 58 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 by striking out in line 12 the words "and the Mount Greylock State
4 Reservation" and inserting in place thereof the words: — Mount
5 Greylock State Reservation, Deer Hill State Reservation, Mount
6 Sugar Loaf State Reservation, Mount Everett State Reservation,
7 Purgatory Chasm State Reservation and the Walden Pond State
8 Reservation,.

The University of Wisconsin

AN ACT TO AMEND THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Wisconsin, in the year 1907.

The first paragraph of Section 12 of the Statutes of Wisconsin, Chapter 12, is hereby amended to read as follows: "The University of Wisconsin shall be a body corporate, and shall have the right to sue and be sued, to hold real and personal property, to acquire and dispose of real and personal property, to contract, to borrow money, and to do all such things as may be necessary to carry out its purposes."
