AN ACT PROHIBITING THE COUNTERFEITING OF TAGS AND SEALS ISSUED BY THE DIVISION OF FISHERIES AND WILDLIFE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 33, as appearing in the 1984 Official Edition, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 Section 33. A person shall not alter, forge or counterfeit any
5 license, permit, permit application, certificate, tag or seal issued
6 under any provisions of this chapter or any rule or regulation
7 made under authority thereof, nor possess or use any such altered,
8 forged or counterfeited license, permit, permit application,
9 certificate, tag or seal, nor procure or attempt to procure a license,
10 permit, permit application, certificate, tag or seal by fraud or false
11 statements of any kind, nor use or attempt to use any license,
12 permit, permit application, certificate, tag or seal of another, nor
13 loan or allow another person to use his license, permit, permit
14 application, certificate, tag or seal.
