AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO MAKE A STUDY RELATIVE TO ACQUIRING A SITE FOR A CENTRAL MASSACHUSETTS STATE OFFICE BUILDING IN THE WORCESTER AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The deputy director of the division of capital planning and
2 operations is hereby authorized to make study relative to
3 acquiring and developing a site for central Massachusetts state
4 office building within the city of Worcester.

5 Said building to be utilized to house all appropriate area and
6 regional offices of the several state departments and divisions. The
7 director shall make a report, including his findings and
8 recommendations, to the clerks of the Senate and House of
9 Representatives by the second Wednesday in November, 1986.
