AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the solemnization of
3 a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emer-
4 gency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
5 convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Andrew Gill Meyer of
5 Sherborn, in the town of Sherborn on August tenth, nineteen
6 hundred and eighty-six between Sheila C. Bernard of Sherborn
7 and Stanley Lever of Braintree and the state secretary shall issue to
8 said Andrew Gill Meyer a certificate of such authorization.
