AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter  
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary  
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-  
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by the Bennington Monthly  
5 Meeting of Friends as they are a Quaker Monthly Meeting in the  
6 state of Vermont in the town of Adams on August second,  
7 nineteen hundred and eighty-six between Anita Bower of the town  
8 of Williamstown and David Ross of the town of Williamstown,  
9 and the state secretary shall issue to the clerk or keeper of records  
10 of the Bennington Monthly Meeting of Friends in his capacity  
11 as aforesaid, a certificate of such authorization.
